- Work with the Vineyard Supervisor to set and oversee vineyard operations and financial plans, including redevelopments, OPEX, CAPEX, compliance and organic conversion;
- Work with Sales & Marketing and Production teams to set and implement efficient and timely bottling schedules;
- Report monthly to the GM on matters such as OPEX, CAPEX, OH&S, S&D, environmental and quality matters;
- Promote the Estate's wines in the market;
- Lead by example.
