



POSITION DESCRIPTION: WINEMAKER

Established in 1988, the 13.8 Ha vineyard has a diverse mix of varieties, including Tempranillo, Riesling, Shiraz, Touriga, Graciano and Mondeuse. With new plantings of alternative varieties coming on-line over the next few years, Mount Majura Vineyard's portfolio will continue to evolve, increasing current winemaking operations.

Reporting to the General Manager/Viticulturist, this is a hands-on role that will be responsible for all winemaking operations. Working closely with the Sales & Marketing team, the Winemaker will be a brand advocate and assist in the growing success of its direct-to-consumer strategy and industry recognition.

- Manage all winemaking operations, driving wine style and quality
- Prepare a production plan to meet forecasts, style, quality and budget
- Complete cellar operations, laboratory analysis and quality control procedures
- Manage winery operating and CapEx budgets and forecasting
- Ensure regulatory compliance & company policies are met, including workplace health & safety standards
- Work closely with the Vineyard team, progressing viticultural plans and liaising on fruit supply and quality
- Develop and implement continual improvement strategies, including sustainable winery practices
- Manage a proactive maintenance plan
- Assist in growth projects for the winery and vineyard, including product development
- Represent the brand at trade and consumer events
- Participate in wine show judging and industry associations
- Manage wine show entries, recording all submissions and achievements
- Contribute to other areas of the business as required, including vineyard work
