



POSITION DESCRIPTION: OPERATIONS WINEMAKER

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Support the Winemaker in planning and executing all day-to-day winemaking operations
- Supervise cellar staff and contractors, ensuring workplace safety standards and legislative compliance
- Prepare wines to style and schedule in line with production standards and quality objectives
- Contribute to tastings, trials, preparation of blends and quality assessment
- Perform laboratory analysis and quality control procedures
- Maintain and adhere to policies and standard operating procedures, driving efficient processes
- Recruitment and training of vintage staff
- Oversee equipment maintenance programs
- Assist with dry goods ordering and stock management
- Assist in maintaining winery records, documenting all cellar operations and compliance requirements
- Participate in brand promotion and representation, including wine show judging and industry events
- Coordinate wine show entries in liaison with Winemaker, recording all submissions and achievements
